Guidelines:

The exhibition is open to all artists over the age of 16 who live in Alabama or an adjacent state.

Submission is free. All entries must be original works of art. Artwork submission must be accompanied by a submission form.

The exhibition accepts all 2–3-dimensional works in abstract, non-representational, or representational are welcome. Acceptable mediums include Acrylic, Ceramics, Charcoal, Collage, Color Pencil, Computer Art, Digital Art, Digital Photography, Drawings, Encaustic, Fiber Arts, Glass Art, Graphite, Gouache, Illustration, Mixed Media, Oil, Pastel, Pen and Ink, Photo Assemblage, Printmaking, Sculpture, Traditional Photography, or Watercolor.

The dimension of each artwork cannot exceed 6 ft x 6 ft x 6 ft.

Selling and Promoting Artworks

Saint Luke's will not conduct sales or take profit of any artwork sales on the behalf of artist. If an artist wants to sell their artwork, they must label the artwork as for sale. If a buyer is interested, Saint Luke's will be happy to pass along the buyer's information to the artist; all business must be conducted outside of the show.

If an artist wants to promote their artwork, they may add additional information below the artwork label such as website and contact info.

Delivery of the Artwork:

Artists must deliver their artwork in person to Saint Luke's church between **November 17th-21st** during church business hours. Please call ahead **256-574-6216** before delivering the artwork. All artwork submissions must be delivered in person or mailed to Saint Luke's no later than November 27th to be considered in the show.

All artworks must be received by the rector, Polly Robb, at Saint Luke's. Each artwork must be accompanied by a completed and signed entry form.

All artworks must be ready to be installed. Saint Luke's reserves the right not to display an artwork if it is not ready for installation.

Saint Luke's reserves the right to refuse any submission for any reason and to photograph and reproduce images of exhibited work for publicity purposes.

Saint Luke's will take every precaution against damage or theft of artwork but will not be responsible for damage or loss whatever the cause.

Artwork return is the total, financial responsibility of the individual artist.

Return and Pick Up of Artwork

All artworks must be collected from Saint Luke's between January 12th to January 26th, 2025.

If the artist is picking up the artwork at Saint Luke's, they must contact **256-574-6216** ahead of time to schedule a pickup date and time.

If the artwork must be mailed back to the artist, the artist is responsible to provide the mailing package and postage fee.

If artwork is not collected by January 26th, 2025, the artist must contact Polly to let Saint Luke's know whether they want the artwork to be donated.

Any artwork that is not picked up by January 31st, 2025, the artworks will become the property of Saint Luke's and will be donated for a good cause.
